

Sporting events and challenges - full terms and conditions:

As an event participant fundraising in aid of BeyondAutism, you agree to:

1. Only use lawful means to fundraise for BeyondAutism, and not to bring the charity's name into disrepute.
2. Any photographs/videos taken of you on the day of, or in the run up to, your event being used by BeyondAutism to raise awareness/or money and promote future events. If you do not wish us to use any photographs/videos of you, you must inform BeyondAutism in writing by emailing: events@beyondautism.org.uk.
3. Ensure that, to the best of your knowledge, you are medically fit to take part in your chosen event. Please note that you participate at your own risk, and BeyondAutism will not be held responsible for any injury or illness resulting from your participation in your chosen event.
4. Read and comply with all terms and conditions issued by the event organiser, and register your details ahead of the deadline. Failure to do so will mean you will not be able to take part in the event.

In addition, if you are participating in an event using a BeyondAutism charity place or in a challenge event where BeyondAutism contributes to the registration fee or costs of your participation, you agree to:

1. Raise at least the minimum fundraising target for the event by the fundraising deadline (4 weeks after the event). For certain events you may have to raise a certain % of this target before the event, check with the event organiser for full details. If you are unable to meet the minimum sponsorship you may choose to make up the balance yourself, or you may lose your place. BeyondAutism reserves the right not to contribute to the registration fee or costs of your place if fundraising targets are not met. Please note that we cannot include the amount raised through Gift Aid in your fundraising total, however please encourage your sponsors to Gift Aid their donations where possible. This increases the value of their donation at no extra cost to them.
2. Let us know as soon as possible if you are injured in advance of the event and unable to take part. Please bear in mind that if you inform us you're dropping out after the registration deadline we will be unable to offer your place to anyone else. If you do not take part in the event, any sponsorship money raised will be treated as donations unless your sponsors contact BeyondAutism directly for a refund.
