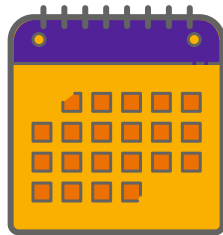


5 top tips for inclusion at school

1

Use visual timetables

Visuals help children with autism build communication and ease transitions. Consider implementing these in your teaching



2

Explain things clearly



Describe exactly what they need to do and why they are learning that to help them understand the process



3

Allow extra time

Tasks may take longer to complete so provide extra time

Consider all communication needs

4

Pupils may find it easier to communicate with signs or PECs. Accommodate all communication needs and encourage children to find their best method



5

Provide a quiet space



Pupils may occasionally need some time alone if anxiety is building. Creating a safe space for them is essential
