Funding is available

The UK Government are providing £650 million of universal catch-up premium funding to all state-funded mainstream and specialist schools, and alternative provisions. Each mainstream school will receive £80 per pupil in years reception through to 11. Special Schools and alternative provisions will be provided with £240 for each place (Coronavirus catch-up premium, [Gov.uk](https://www.gov.uk)).

School readiness

A combination of professional training and early intervention for children with autism. Our CPD accredited training aims to develop the knowledge and skills of Teaching Assistants, helping mainstream primary schools to meet the needs of children with autism. With early intervention, children develop skills that are essential to access learning in a mainstream classroom and make progress that will have a long-term positive impact on their quality of life and independence. The aim of this programme is to keep children in their local mainstream schools and reduce the number of exclusions.

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Training from experienced specialists

In the autumn term we will be offering the following training, delivered by our experienced team:

- **Introduction to autism – a course for professionals** – 1 day, Monday 23rd November 2020

- **Strategies to manage behaviours that challenge: a behaviour analysis approach** – 2 days, Wednesday, 21st – Thursday 22nd October 2020
 - This 2-day course provides a comprehensive introduction to behaviour analysis and its application to managing behaviours that challenge

- **Sensory and social story time for children with autism** – 1 day – Monday 9th November 2020
 - Participants will have the opportunity to learn practical tips on how to tailor any story to a child's level of development and use props to make the story even more enjoyable and interactive to maintain a child's attention throughout the story
