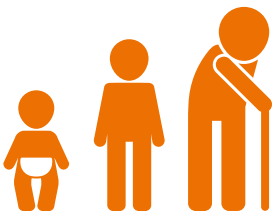

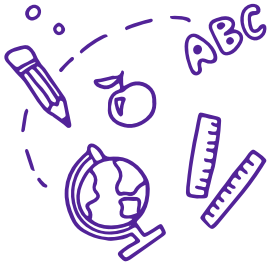

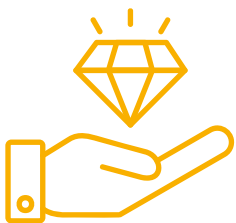
## Reduced school placement breakdown

What support do you find helpful in the workplace?



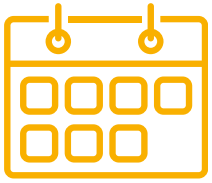

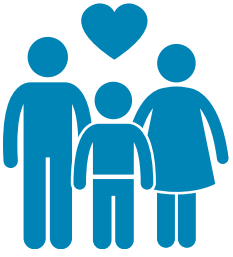
